The district has modified the admittance criteria for the Advance Program to ensure a more equitable admittance process for all JCPS students. The new admittance criteria is listed below. ## JCPS Advance Program Admittance Criteria

- CogAT score of 21 or higher (up to 4 points)
- MAP score of $77^{\text {th }}$ percentile or higher (up to 4 points)
- GPA Average of 3.2 or higher (up to 3 points)
- KPREP (up to 2 points)
- High-Achievers Characteristics Checklist - complete by teacher (up to 4 points)
- A total of at least 7 selection points (for the 2021-22 school year only - incoming $4^{\text {th }}$ graders with a total of at least 5 selection points due to no CogAT score)
