_____ Choose an appropriate reading approach (i.e., student reads independently, reads aloud, takes part in shared reading).

_____ Provides activities **before** reading

- Examines book's title
- Conducts a picture walk
- Employs a prediction
- Introduces unfamiliar words
- Makes a connection to the child's experience
- Establishes a purpose for reading a particular book

_____ Provides activities **during** reading

- Poses prediction questions to gauge student's comprehension
- Uses prompts when necessary

_____ Provides activities **after** reading

- Allows student to retell the story
- Asks open-ended comprehension questions
- Connects the text to the student's life (i.e., uses memory makers)
- Uses, as time allows, a follow-up activity, such as writing, drawing, or a word game
