Results To Date:

1st Quarter: 83 elementary students improved their attendance compared to the same time period last year. On average, elementary students missed 1.6 fewer days (i.e., 3.5 days vs. 5.1 days) by mid-year. The goal is to have a minimum of 70 students improve school attendance by the end of the year.

2nd Quarter:	79 elementary students improved their year to date attendance compared to the same time date last year (April 11, 2010). On averge, elementary students missed 2 fewer days (i.e., 7 days vs. 9 days). The goal is to have a minimum of 70 students improve school attendance by the end of the year. So far, REACH elementary students have missed 216 fewer days in 2011 compared to 2010.
