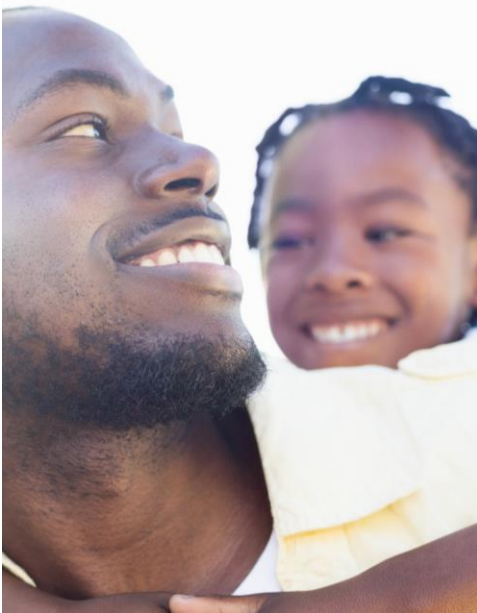


Register NOW for Kindergarten!

WHY Kindergarten Registration is Important?

Kindergarten is an important step to your child's success in life. That's why it's so important to register during the early application period!

1. It guarantees your child has a spot for the first day of school.
2. It provides the school with the information they need to communicate with you about important information you need to know before the first day of school. This includes things like supply lists, helpful hints, even a preview day where your child can come and see the school and meet teachers. This makes the first day easier for them. (And you!)
3. It's an important step in helping your child successfully transition to kindergarten, helping you, your child and the school to all be as prepared as possible on day one.



WHEN to Register

**Enrollment for the 2018
school year** beginning
August of 2018 actually
begins **Oct. 30-Dec. 15, 2017!**

Kindergarten Registration & Application is Easy!

What to bring to register your child:

- A photo ID (driver's license, student ID)
- Proof of address (LG&E bill, water bill, paycheck stub, lease/housing contract, government-issued document)

More important things to know:

- You can walk in and register at any JCPS elementary school during the school day, even if it is not the school your child will attend.
- You can register and apply to enroll your child in school regardless of immigration status, if you might move, or you live in temporary housing.
- When you register, you get connected to a school and a Family Resource Center so you can ask questions, get school supplies and other resources to help your child succeed.
- Get involved in school choice: rank the schools within your cluster and choose up to two optional/magnet programs or schools. All incoming kindergarten students have to apply to receive a school assignment for the 2018-2019 school year.
