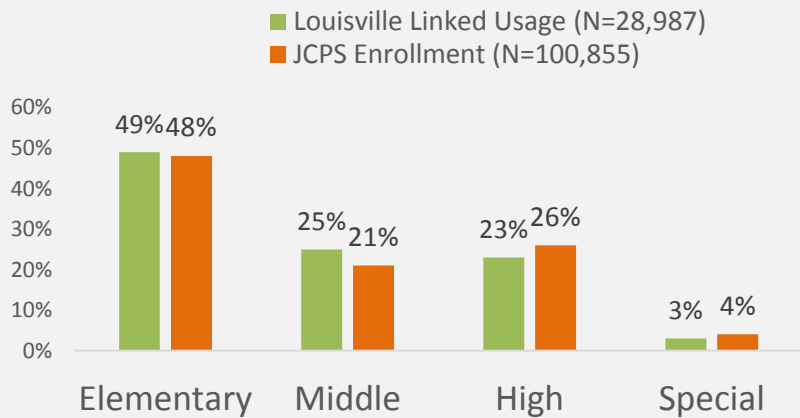
Cumulative Unique Students “Linked”*

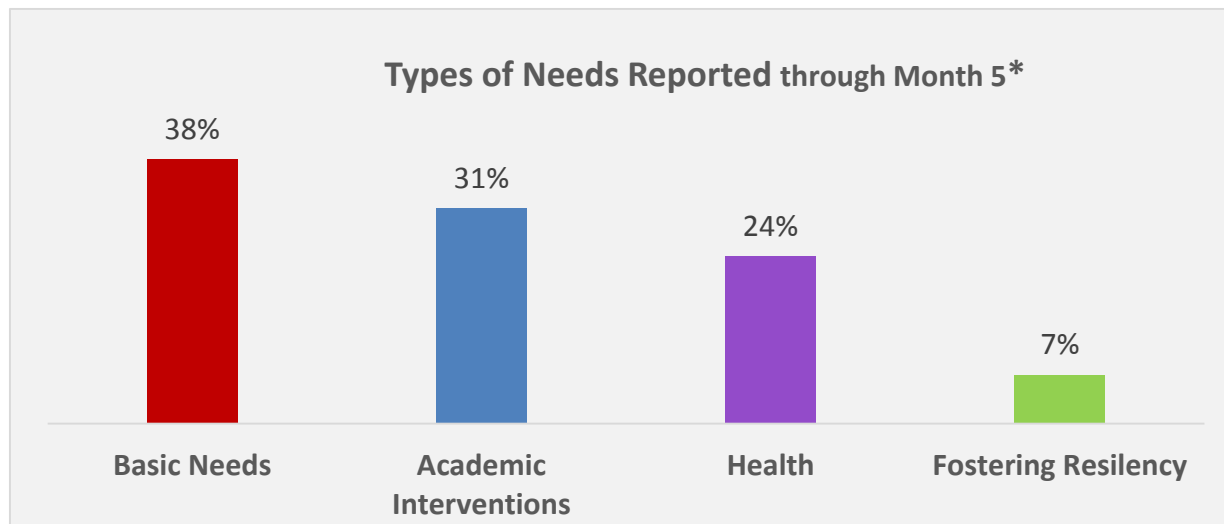
