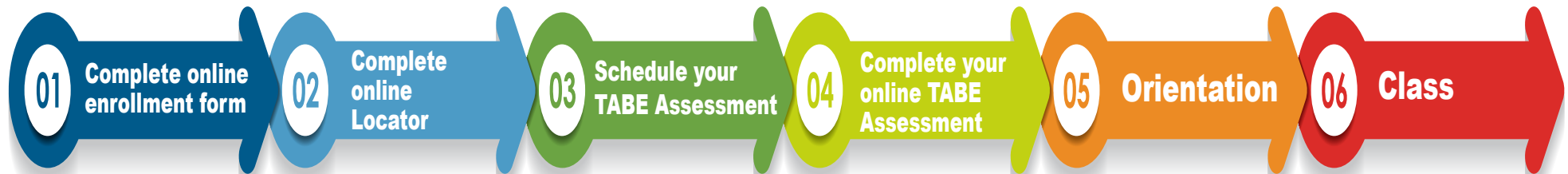

You will receive a link to complete a short online assessment called the Locator.

The Locator helps us determine which level of the TABE assessment you need to take.

The Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) is an assessment that lets you know if you are GED®-ready or if you need to brush up on your reading and math skills before taking the GED® Test.

You will receive a scheduling form to choose the time that is most convenient for you to test online.

The TABE has two parts - reading and math. You will complete both sections during your scheduled online appointment.

If your TABE scores indicate you are GED®-ready, staff will provide vouchers for you to take the GED Ready® Test (the pre-GED® Test required by the state) free of charge.

A voucher code is also provided to take each section of the GED Test free of charge.

If your TABE scores indicate you need some brush up before taking the GED Test, you will be asked to attend an online orientation prior to joining your first virtual class.

You will be given the class name and Zoom link along with your instructor's name and contact information. We will let you know the days and times your class meets online.
