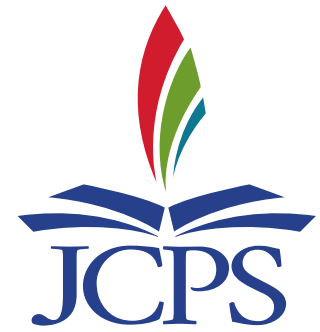


What we did:

What we heard:

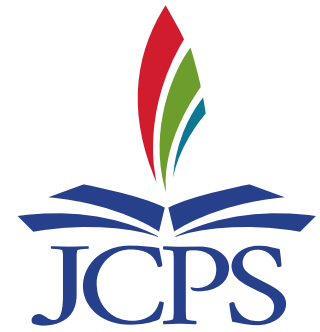
- Choice should be accessible

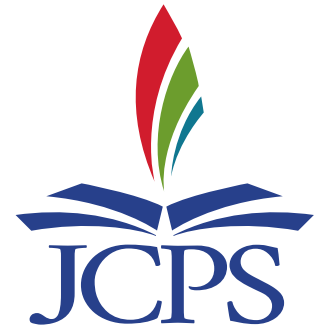

Categories of Questions

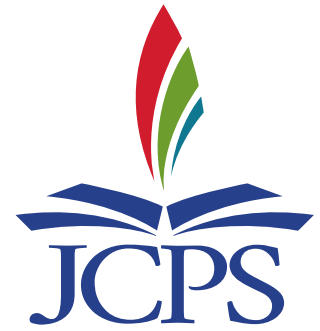
- Understanding of current student assignment plan (5)

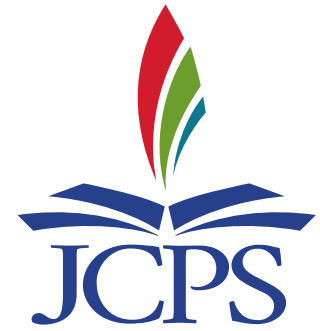

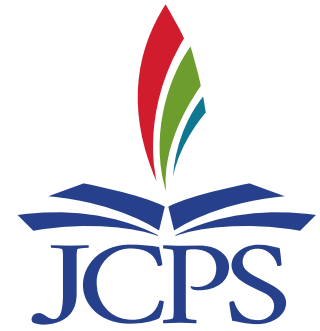
